1. Approval of the minutes of the 2010 Annual General Meeting

2. Financial report for 2010-11 year

^{**} The club received a Mainland Trust grant of \$2000, and a NZ Community Trust grant of \$1300 towards events; of the latter \$507.65 was refunded due to a change of plan surrounding the purchasing of a small sound system.

The event expenses total excludes a deposit of \$2350 paid to Living Springs for hosting the MTB club conference in July 2011. This amount will be shown as an expense in next year's accounts, and matched against income for the event.

Bank balances at BNZ and SBS Bank total \$4119.28 as at the end of June 2011.

Although some equipment purchases will last for more than a year, they have all been expensed.

3. Club membership

The total number of members for the 2010-11 year was 187, consisting of 130 members rejoining from the previous year, and 57 new members.

4. Election of Executive Committee members for the 2011-12 year.

With no additional nominations for the chairperson, secretary or treasurer roles, the continuation by Rebekah, Craig and Jeff was moved by Greg Milne and seconded by Michelle Peterson.

Marie Jenkins was the only new expression of interest for becoming a general member for the 2011-12 year. Marie's nomination was moved by Greg Milne and seconded by Graham Allan, making the 2011-12 committee structure as follows:

5. Election of off-committee roles for the 2011-12 year

Craig then presented the proposed event schedule for 2011-12:




